## About The Scholarship

The purpose of the ACA Corrosion Professional Scholarship is to provide a chance for a corrosion professional to extend their scientific knowledge through attending the annual ACA conference.

The objective of this scholarship is to foster involvement of corrosion industry professionals in the ACA, and is open to all applicants.

This scholarship is open to applicants from all areas of corrosion related industries including, but not limited to: galvanizing, cathodic protection, coating specification and sales, coating applicators, structural engineers, materials scientists and engineers, and researchers.

The Award is judged by the ACA Foundation Awards Committee upon submission of a 250 word written statement outlining your current experience in the Corrosion Industry and fields of Corrosion Science and a 250 word written statement on How you believe attendance at the Corrosion and Prevention Conference will further your path in the Corrosion Industry.

## Guidelines for Eligibility and Awarding of the ACA Professional Scholarship

1. Applicant is a citizen or permanent resident of Australia or New Zealand
2. Is working in the industry or studying in a field of corrosion science
3. If requested, applicants must provide proof of residency/citizenship.
4. The application must be submitted to the ACA by the deadline and include a completed submission form and all required documentation.
5. Scholarships are only awarded in response to applications. If no applications have been received that the judging panel believe warrant a scholarship, then no scholarships will be awarded.
6. The ACA Foundation Award Committees decision is final.
7. Each scholarship recipient will be contacted by the ACA and their names/images will appear in ACA collateral.
8. Award recipients will be asked to provide a 250 word report of their experience at conference and participate in a photo of the Award recipients at conference; the report must arrive within 1 month of attendance at the conference.
9. The ACA reserves the right to offer more than one scholarship to a particular branch should we fail to receive a sufficient number of qualified applicants from another ACA Branch.
10. The ACA reserves the right to award further scholarships at its discretion should the recipients of this scholarship receive any alternative scholarship that grants a comparable award.
11. The recipient of the award will receive a member ticket conference registration, as well as airfares and accommodation expenses up to the amount of \$800 AUD. Additional minor per diem expenses will be considered up to the \$800 amount on presentation of receipts.
