



# Young Corrosion Professional Scholarship

## About The Scholarship

The purpose of the Young Corrosion Professional Scholarship is to provide a chance for a young corrosion professional to extend their scientific knowledge through attending the annual ACA conference.

The objective of this Scholarship is to foster involvement of emerging industry professionals in the ACA, and is aimed at ACA members under 35 years old who would not otherwise have the opportunity to attend the ACA's National Annual conference.

This Scholarship is open to applicants from all areas of corrosion related industries including, but not limited to: galvanizing, cathodic protection, coating specification and sales, coating applicators, structural engineers, materials scientists and engineers, and researchers.

The Scholarship is judged by the YCG Steering Committee upon submission of a 250 word written statement outlining your current experience in the Corrosion Industry and fields of Corrosion Science and a 250 word written statement on How you believe attendance at the Corrosion and Prevention Conference will further your path in the Corrosion Industry.

## Guidelines for Eligibility and Awarding of the Young Corrosion Professional Scholarship

1. Applicant is 35 years or younger as at 14 November 2021 and has less than 10 years' experience in the Corrosion industry.
2. Applicant is a citizen or permanent resident of Australia
3. Be working in the industry or studying in a field of corrosion science
4. If requested, applicants must provide proof of age and residency/citizenship.
5. Be a member or student member of the ACA, or an employee of a corporate member organisation
6. The application must be submitted to the ACA by the deadline, including the following details;
  - Name & contact details
  - Company or Institution details
  - 250 word outline of your , an item of particular local or historical relevance, or an industrial case study
  - Letter from company/institution supporting the application
7. Scholarships are only awarded in response to applications. If no applications have been received that the judging panel believe warrant a scholarship, then no scholarship will be awarded.
8. The YCG Steering Committees decision is final.
9. Each scholarship recipient will be contacted by the ACA and their names/images will appear in ACA collateral.
10. Scholarship recipients will be asked to provide a 250 word report of their experience at conference and participate in a photo of the Scholarship recipients at conference; the report must arrive within 1 month of attendance at the conference.
11. The ACA reserves the right to offer more than two scholarships to a particular branch should we fail to receive a sufficient number of qualified applicants from another ACA Branch.
12. The ACA reserves the right to award further scholarships at its discretion should the recipients of this scholarship receive any alternative award or scholarship that grants a comparable award.
